Leader Construction Teachers Project



Leader Construction Teachers Project was presented to Directorate of European Union and Financial Assistance of Ministry of Labour and Social Security by INTES.

The contract for Leader Construction Teachers Project whose funder is the Delegation of the European Union to Turkey was signed between Directorate of European Union and Financial Assistance of Ministry of Labour and Social Security and INTES on 15 December 2021. The starting date for the project activities is 1 February 2022.

Teachers are the people to educate qualified labour force in the construction sector and to evaluate the performance of employees. In this regard, Leader Construction Teachers Project was developed with the aim of enriching the vocational competence of construction teachers.

The aim of the project is to educate construction teachers that would meet the needs of the sector by developing existing educational programs in schools. Based on this aim, educational programs were arranged with the aim of improving the competence of 150 vocational construction teacher in accordance with innovations and making contributions to their developments.

The final beneficiary of this project is vocational construction teachers of the Ministry of National Education. The indirect beneficiaries are Vocational Qualifications Authority of Ministry of Labour and Social Security, vocational high school students and construction technologies students.

The aims of the project are listed as below:

- Establishing INTES Sectoral Competence Development Centre

- The creation of new teaching materials on the sub-branches of gypsum board operator, construction painter and scaffolding personnel by the teachers that would complete on-the-job trainings
- The creation of sectoral cooperation network platform thanks to industry-school cooperation
- The education of the construction students in such a way that they will meet sectoral needs and be employed in their field of education after graduation

To achieve these targets, the studies on training needs analysis have started. In this regard, our Association did joint studies with producing companies and technical teachers.
