The Opening Meeting of Our Improving the Quality of Vocational and Technical Education through the Establishment of Sectoral Centres of Excellence Grant Program Leading Structural Trainers Project was held on Thursday, July 28, 2022 at The Ankara Hotel.

The opening speeches of the meeting were delivered by Mr. Celal Koloğlu, the Chairman of the Board of Directors of İNTES, Prof. Dr. Mustafa Balcı, the Education and Training Sector Manager of the Delegation of the European

Commission to Turkey, Mrs. Süreyya Erkan, the Head of the EU and Financial Assistance Department of the Ministry of Labor and Social Security, and Mrs. Nazan Şener, the Director General of Vocational and Technical Education of the Ministry of National Education.
